The Hidden Disabilities Sunflower is here every day of the year to support people living with non-visible disabilities in their communities by raising awareness, training businesses and sharing stories to help create a more inclusive, understanding society.

Since its launch in 2016, businesses from every sector have been joining the global Sunflower network, including over 200 airports.

The Sunflower has now been launched in Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, Denmark, Ireland, Latin America, the Netherlands, New Zealand, the UK, the UAE and the USA."

## What are the Benefits?


Display non-visible disabilities in a discrete way, which allows airport staff to recognize and support what you need.

Helps reduce the stress of travelling with hidden disabilities.

Recognized (mostly) worldwide at most major airports and various airlines.

Supports you throughout your journey through the airport every step of the way. This could mean locations to help with sensitivities, a special space within the airport, or just given extra attention and patience by workers at the airport.

Be allowed to clear security through the accessibility lines.
